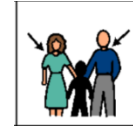


Going to Storytime at the Public Library

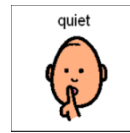
I am going to storytime at the library on Saturday.



My mom or dad, or another special person, will stay with me during storytime.



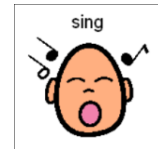
In the library I use a quiet voice and I stay close to Mom or Dad.

I feel safe and calm in storytime.

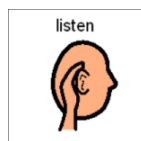
I try to stay on my special mat unless one of the librarians tells me to stand for an activity.
