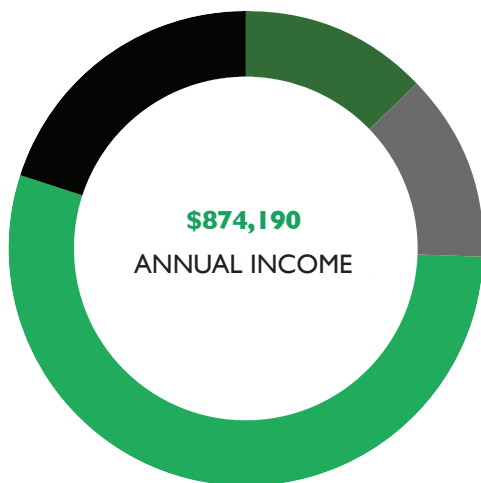

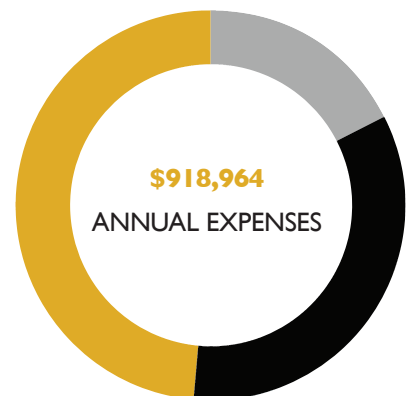


ANNUAL INCOME
